

Top 5 Cleansers For Luxury Bath Systems

Luxury has received numerous calls regarding the best way to maintain Luxury's acrylic bath system. The top 5 cleansers that we recommend are:

1. Dawn dish soap & Vinegar
2. Formula 409 all purpose cleaner
3. Scrub Free Soap Scum Remover
4. X-IT all purpose cleaner
5. 3-M Scotch Brite Pads* or Chore Boy* in conjunction with any of the above cleansers

*rated for Teflon or non-stick cookware



One of the most effective cleansers is a homemade solution of 1 capful of Dawn, 1 capful of vinegar and fill the rest of a spray bottle with water. This solution will safely and effectively clean the acrylic and loosen any mineral deposits. To remove larger build-ups of soap and shampoo residue, be sure to use a light duty Scotch Brite or Chore Boy pad along with Scrub Free Soap Scum Remover formula. If the homeowner requires a disinfectant, they may safely use Formula 409 or diluted Clorox bleach as necessary (always rinse surfaces with water after cleaning with any chemicals). Another approved cleanser is Emulso's X-IT which is an effective all purpose cleanser that is 100% organic making it safe for all bathroom applications. For removing light scratches and abrasions use Mirror Glaze Professional Formula #17 or a liquid acrylic car wax. What Effect Does Soap Have on Acrylic?

Have you noticed that certain soaps are more difficult to remove from Luxury's acrylic surface than other soaps? We have heard reports from the field citing deodorant bar soap residue is the most difficult to dissolve using the approved cleansers mentioned above. Conversely, liquid soap seems to be the easiest to remove from the tubliners. We are continuing to test the long term effects of repeated use of different soaps on the acrylic surfaces.
